



The Friday Men's League *at Holly Ridge*

2014 Information and Guidelines

- ❖ **OPENING DAY IS APRIL 11th**
- ❖ The **WEEKLY ENTRY FEE** is \$6.00 cash (the entry fee for this league cannot be paid by credit card). The sole purpose of the entry fee is to go toward prizes. Every member of the league pays the weekly entry fee.
- ❖ **HOLE-IN-ONE POOL** A separate collection will be taken for a hole-in-one pool. Holes-in-one will not supersede the weekly birdie pool. All league members must pay a \$5 (cash) hole-in-one pool fee before the first league day that they play. The first league member to get a hole-in-one during league play will receive the hole-in-one pool money. Another collection of \$5 will then be taken. Remember, on a par three course, every player has a great chance at a hole-in-one.
- ❖ **TEE TIMES** A block of tee times will be reserved for the league from **7:30 to 9:00 am**. If the league grows (the more the merrier!), the tee time block will be extended. Players who are unable to play during this block of time can play in the afternoon as long as there is at least one other league player in the group (total of at least two league players). Those who play in the afternoon will make their own tee time directly with someone in the shop, not on the league sign-up tee sheet.
- ❖ League members **MUST make a tee time**. A sign-up sheet for tee times for the following week will be available each Friday before and after you go out to play, or you can call the pro shop to make a tee time. **Even though you may play regularly, you will not be automatically entered into a tee time each week.**
- ❖ **CANCELLATIONS/NO-SHOWS** If you have made a tee time and you cannot play, PLEASE call the pro shop as far in advance as possible to cancel. It is fully understood that things come up or you may not feel well. Holly Ridge asks, and greatly appreciates, that you call to cancel. If a league member has a tee time and does not show and does not call to cancel, that player will be marked as a no-show. If a league member accumulates three no-shows, that player will not be allowed to play for three weeks, no exceptions.

❖ **LEAGUE FORMAT** The main format for this league is a quota format (please see attached explanation of the quota format). In addition, there will be “special” tournaments held at times throughout the season and an end-of-season league championship.

❖ **SCORING**

HANDICAPS - League Members must pay the \$10 Annual Handicap Fee

Please note: New members to this league who do not have a current Holly Ridge handicap may provide us with another course handicap and we will convert it, or they will simply begin establishing a handicap from their first round.

POSTING - PLEASE post your adjusted score on the posting sheets (follow the posting parameters that are listed on the board) in the hallway. Make sure the scorecard is dated, signed and attested. After that’s done, turn in your scorecard to the pro shop desk. Please note: If you play on a non-league day, don’t forget to post your score.

PICK-UP RULE For truer handicap purposes and for pace of play purpose, the local rule for all players in leagues is as follows: If your ball is not in the hole in 6 strokes, pick up and score 7X for that hole. **There are NO GIMMIES.** All putts must be played out (unless you’re picking up after six strokes of course).

❖ **PRIZES** Prizes will be awarded as cash.

QUOTA FORMAT

Each player is given a point quota based on his course handicap. Points are scored as follows: Bogey = 1; Par = 2; Birdie = 4; Eagle = 8.

Find your point quota opposite your Course Handicap in the Table below:

Example: Tom has a 17 handicap and he earns 16 points during his 18 hole round. Tom's point quota for the round is -3. Joe has a 13 handicap and he earns 25 points during his 18 hole round. His point quota for the round is +2. +2 is better than -3.
